Re: 1" Overlays on driveways

Good Afternoon Paul,

ICPI is aware of the practice of using 1" pavers either "dry-packed" or thin set over existing concrete pavements. Tech Spec 10 mentions thin paving units on page 6 and notes that they should not be used in any vehicular application. Currently the "dry-pack" method is not recognized as a best installation practice and consequently is not presented in the ICPI literature. Overlays using thin set installation methods are included in ICPI tech notes and guide specs (See page 7 of Tech Spec 10). However, as noted these applications are for pedestrian loading only. Thin set overlays do not perform well under vehicular loading. It is also possible to sand-set pavers in overlay applications (See the attached guide spec), and again this type of installation is for pedestrian applications only.
